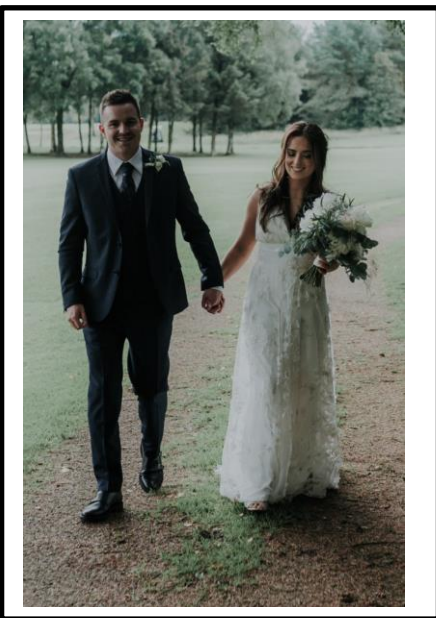

They have both asked me to pass on their thanks for the cards, gifts and well wishes received from our parents.

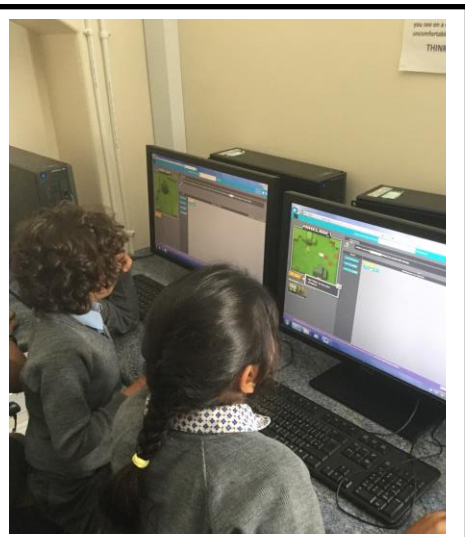
We wish you both every happiness together!
